CD/USB Receiver Firmware Update Guide

Introduction

- This document describes the procedure and precautions for upgrading the CD/ USB receiver firmware.
- If an error occurs while you are updating the firmware, the CD/USB receiver may become unusable. Be sure to read the following procedure and precautions carefully before updating the firmware.
- For basic operations of the CD/USB receiver, refer to the appropriate instruction manual for your model.

Target Model and Firmware Version

Firmware versions for Device3

Ver 207 or earlier → Ver 208

Firmware versions for Device4

Ver 10.1.3 or earlier → Ver 11.0.2

Work Flow

- **Step 1** Download the firmware files, and copy them to USB memory.
- **Step 2** Update the firmware for device3. (It takes about 2 minutes) Reset the CD/USB receiver.
- **Step 3** Update the firmware for device4. (It takes about 12 minutes) Reset the CD/USB receiver.
- **Step 4** Check that the firmware has been updated.

Creating the Update Media

Create the update media on your PC.

- Download the appropriate updater for the model and firmware version to update.
- 2. Copy the updater to the top of hierarchy in USB memory.



- You can also copy the updater to a device containing audio files and update the firmware from it.
- Update cannot be performed if it is copied inside a folder.
- If the updater file name is changed, update cannot be performed.

Checking the Firmware Version

- 1. Press the [SRC] button and select "STANDBY" (standby state).
- 2. Press the [Volume] knob to enter the function mode.
- 3. Turn the [Volume] knob to display "Initial Settings", and press the [Volume] knob.
- 4. Turn the [Volume] knob to display "F/W Update", and press the [Volume] knob. Current firmware version is displayed.

Firmware Update Procedure

Firmware versions for Device3

 Connect the USB memory to the front USB input terminal of the CD/USB receiver.



Do not connect anything to the rear USB input terminal.

- 2. When an audio file is played or "No Media File" is displayed, press the [SRC] button and select "STANDBY" (standby state).
- 3. Press the [Volume] knob to enter the function mode.
- 4. Turn the [Volume] knob to display "Initial Settings", and press the [Volume]
- 5. Turn the [Volume] knob to display "F/W Update", and press the [Volume] knob.
- 6. Turn the [Volume] knob to display "Device3", and press the [Volume] knob.
- 7. Press the [Volume] knob again.
- 8. Turn the [Volume] knob to display "YES", and press the [Volume] knob.
 Update starts with "Updating" displayed. Update should finish in
 approximately 2 minutes and "Device3 Completed" is displayed upon
- 9. Press the Release button to Detach the faceplate.
- 10. Press the Reset button.

completion

- Update on the firmware takes effect.
- 11. Reattaching the Faceplate

Firmware versions for Device4

- 12. Press the [SRC] button and select "STANDBY" (standby state).
- 13. Press the [Volume] knob to enter the function mode.
- 14. Turn the [Volume] knob to display "Initial Settings", and press the [Volume] knob
- 15. Turn the [Volume] knob to display "F/W Update", and press the [Volume] knob.
- 16. Turn the [Volume] knob to display "Device4", and press the [Volume] knob.
- 17. Press the [Volume] knob again.
- 18. Turn the [Volume] knob to display "YES", and press the [Volume] knob.
 Update starts with "Updating" displayed. Update should finish in
 approximately 12 minutes and "Device4 Completed" is displayed upon
- 19. Press the Release button to Detach the faceplate.
- 20. Press the Reset button.

completion.

Update on the firmware takes effect.

- 21. Reattaching the Faceplate
- 22. Check that the firmware version is updated, by referring to "Checking the Firmware Version".



• When "No File" is displayed

- Check if the updater is on the top of hierarchy.
- Check if the updater file name is appropriate for the model to update.

Precautions

- Be sure to park the vehicle in a safe place before updating. Keep the engine running in order to prevent battery from running out.
- Do not turn off the engine or CD/USB receiver power while updating. Update cannot be performed correctly and the CD/USB receiver may become unusable.
